Tombstone Inscriptions in Carlingford Churchyard

Transcribed by PATRICK F. POWER and ALLAN B. SWAN

Carlingford church and graveyard are beautifully situated overlooking the harbour and the lough and facing the Mourne mountains. There are references to it in the fourteenth century so that the foundation is old, although the nave of the present church would probably date from early in the nineteenth century.

The tower of the present building is of much earlier date and is probably one of the towers of the original town walls which has been incorporated into the church building. On the outside of the east side of the tower, above the roof of the present nave, can be seen the much steeper

roof-line of the older medieval building.

In recording the inscriptions in the graveyard, we did not find any which dated back to the seventeenth century although a number of those who are commemorated would have been born in that century. As one might expect from its situation close to the sea, there are memorials to several men who lost their lives in the lough or on the bar at the entrance to it.
